From The Minister



As we enter the July 4 week-end, let us thank God for the freedom we have and for those who gave their lives that we might be free. A little history might be in order at this time.

Some 60 plus years this summer, then President Dwight D. Eisenhower signed the joint resolution adopting "In God We Trust" as our official National Motto. This phrase first appeared on our coins during the Civil War, 1864.

In the war of 1812, Francis Scott Key went aboard the British ship Tennant in an effort to secure the release of the prominent surgeon, Dr. William Beanes. There he dined and was told the prisoner would be released, but they would not do so until the British Navy attacked Baltimore.


While detained aboard the ship, Key witnessed the British navy bombard Fort McHenry. During the rainy night, Key observed that the fort's smaller "storm flag" continued to fly but once the shelling stopped, he would not know how the battle had turned out until dawn. On the morning of September 14, 1814 the storm flag had been lowered and the larger flag had been raised. Key wrote a poem that would later become our National Anthem.

While the National anthem has four verses, we seldom sing or hear more that the first. But in the fourth verse you find the line: "and this be our motto - - In God Is Our Trust."

May "In God We Trust" be more than a motto embossed on our coins. May it be a truth that is engraved in our hearts, a truth that daily guides our actions and attitudes. The Proverb writer says it like this;

"Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge Him, and He will make straight your paths" (Proverbs 3:5-6



Kids Activity Page:




Summer is the perfect time to gaze at the wonders in the sky. Make this craft as a reminder of God's handiwork — including you!

What you need:


- Glass jar
- Permanent marker
- Glue (and water)
- Paper plate
- Paintbrush
- Star sequins
- Battery-operated tea light

What you do:

- 1. Around the jar's opening, write in permanent marker: Shine ... like stars in the sky. Philippians 2:15
- Pour some glue on the plate. Thin with some water.
- 3. "Paint" the outside of the jar with glue and then sprinkle on some sequins. Let dry.
- 4. Add the tea light and give your bedroom a starry glow at nighttime.
