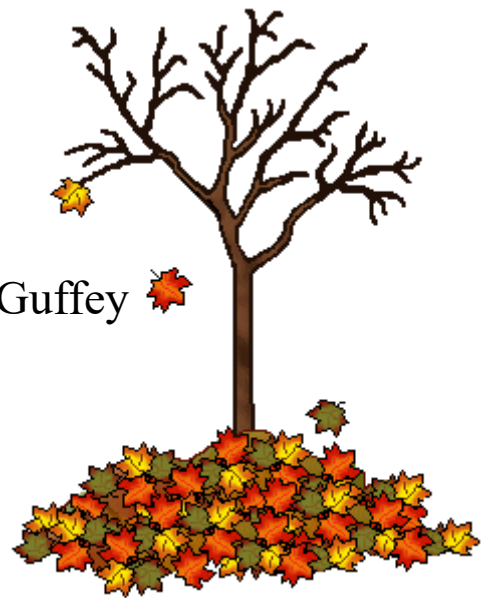

Three Illustrations on Thanksgiving should cause us to truly be thankful for what God has given us.

- II. We can always look across the fence and it looks like that pasture on the other man’s side is greener, but probably all that means is that he has a larger septic than you have.
- III. Dr. Tom Long attended a rather wealthy Presbyterian Church in Nassau (right outside of Princeton). The church was full each Sunday of people who had great financial capabilities. Their church took on offering every month for the cause of world hunger. They would invite worshipers to bring their gifts to the altar.

One Sunday, as they got to this part of the service, an older, oddly-dressed homeless woman came forward. They knew they were taking this very offering for people like her. In fact, they were afraid she might help herself to some of the gifts as she approached the altar. They watched her as she drew near.

Then she fell down on her knees and clasped her hands in prayer. She prayed intensely and then rose and went back to the pew. There were few dry eyes in the church house that day. Why? Because they had experienced a real thanksgiving. Yes, the woman may have been poor, but she knew the kind of thanksgiving offering that really matters - - the yielding of our hearts to God.

And that’s what ***Thanksgiving*** is all about!

What you need:

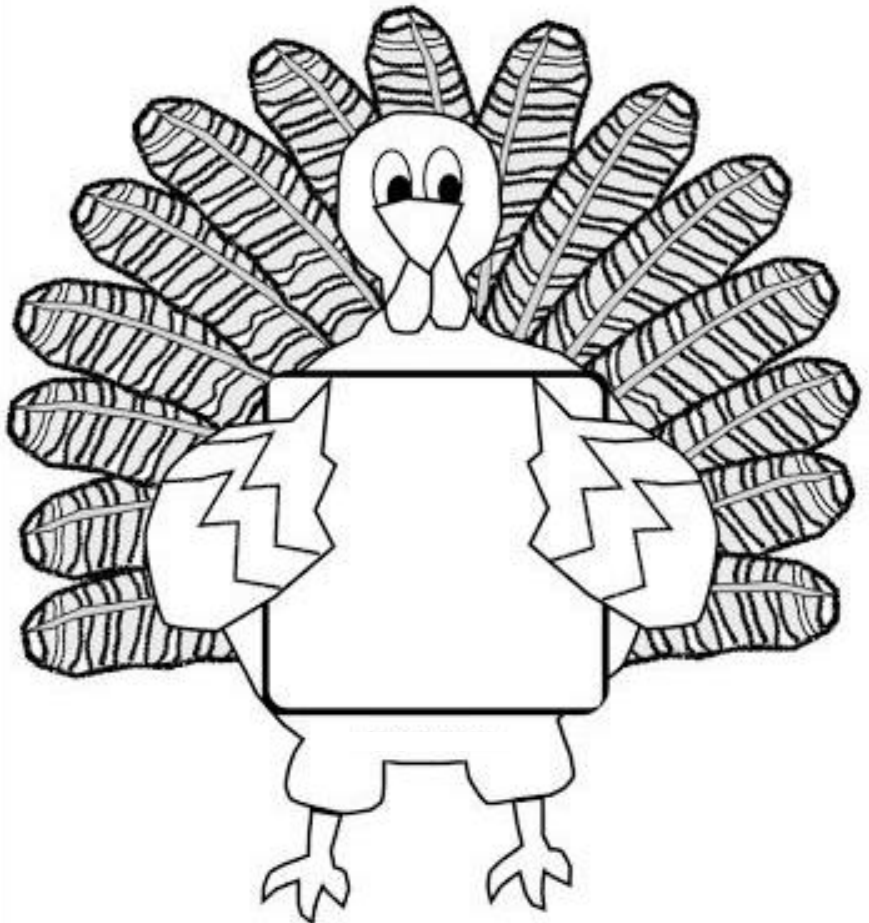
- Large pieces of paper
